IMPORTANT REMINDERS

School starts at 8.45am and finishes at 2.45pm

Students are welcome at school any time **AFTER 8.15am - no earlier please** - (Bus students are an exception)

- **ABSENCES**: As class rolls are marked as soon as the bell goes at 8.45am, we would appreciate it if you could ring/text/email any absences to the school office by 9am please.
- **PARKING**: Please remember the staff carpark is for staff only. This is a safety requirement as people use the carpark to access bins. There is parking on Union road, and also on Titi road by the side gate.
- **BRAIN FOOD SNACK:** Please remember to include a healthy "brain food" snack in your child's lunchbox. This should be something quick and easy, like fruit, veges, nuts etc.
- **2024 BUS COSTS:** Bus fees need to be paid on time to ensure your child can travel by bus. The cost is \$15 per week per child - one way \$7.50. Payment options are:
 - Full term payment \$100 per child, or \$200 for 2 or more children.
 - Paying a full year at once \$300 per student, or \$500 for a family (2 or more children).

Community Notices


This Saturday 23 March Pukekohe AFC will be running their annual 'give it a go' morning for children to try their winter football programmes before the season starts.
