STUDENT WELLBEING

At Mauku School, we are continuing to strengthen our focus Focus on student safety and emotional wellbeing as part of our commitment to hauora, by introducing Pulse from Week 3, Term 1.

Pulse is a simple, private weekly check-in tool that helps students build mindfulness, emotional awareness, and self-regulation skills while giving them a safe way to share how they are feeling and seek support if needed.

The tool supports our social and emotional learning Programme and helps staff notice wellbeing patterns so they can respond early with appropriate support for individuals, classes, or year levels. Students answer a small number of guided questions, with identifiable responses visible only to relevant staff, while wider data is viewed in anonymous group form.
